



Daily Lesson Focus and Bible Verses

Day One, The Two Kingdoms

Bible Passages

- Creator King and Prince of Darkness John 18:37–38; Ephesians 6:10–11 & Savior King Genesis 1–3; Gospels; Ephesians 6:14

Apologetics Content

- Absolute truth is true for all people, for all times, for all circumstances.
- Build a biblical worldview to stand strong in the truth.

Veritas Verse

- Be strong in the Lord and in the strength of his might. Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the schemes of the devil. Ephesians 6:10–11
- Stand therefore, having fastened on the belt of truth, and having put on the breastplate of righteousness. Ephesians 6:14

Lesson Focus

- We're in a battle between two kingdoms—God's good kingdom that is based on truth and the enemy's bad kingdom that is based on lies.
- Each child of the King needs to fasten on the belt of truth.

Day 2 – The Breastplate and The Shoes

Bible Passages

King Josiah- 2 Kings 22–23; Ephesians 6:15

Apologetics Content

Put on what's right (Jesus' righteousness), then do right.

Veritas Verse

And, as shoes for your feet, having put on the readiness given by the gospel of peace. Ephesians 6:15

Lesson Focus

Put on the breastplate of righteousness and the shoes of peace.

Day 3- The Shield and The Helmet

Bible Passages

King Solomon- 1 Kings 2–11; Ephesians 6:16–17a

Apologetics Content

Guard against false teachings and temptations.

Veritas Verse

In all circumstances take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming darts of the evil one. Ephesians 6:16

Lesson Focus

Take the shield of faith and the helmet of salvation. These will guard you from the enemy's attacks.

Day 4- The Sword and Prayer

Bible Passages

King of Kings vs. Prince of the Air- Matthew 4:1–11; Ephesians 6:17-18a

Apologetics Content

Be ready to give an answer for the hope that is in you.

Veritas Verse

And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God, praying at all times in the Spirit. Ephesians 6:17–18a

Lesson Focus

Take the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God, and pray at all times.
